Specific parts like cylinder heads, crankshafts, cylinder blocks and connecting rods are reground, resurfaced and resized if necessary. Other parts like for example gears, nuts, bolts and all that, are repaired or replaced as considered necessary.

When the overhaul has been done, the engine is rebuilt by hand. After being reassembled, a series of tests are applied to the working equipment to be able to check all of the components and make certain there are no leaks or problems. If any problems occur, the necessary changes are made.
